At the Government House at Wellington, this 7th day of August, 1940.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Transport Licensing Emergency Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport Licensing Emergency Regulations 1940.*
- 3. While these regulations continue in force, clause 18 of the Applied Provisions of the Transport (Goods) Order 1936† shall have effect, and as from the 26th day of June, 1940, it shall be deemed to have had effect, as if the reference in clause (3) thereof to fourteen clear days were a reference to seven clear days.
