



**THE TRANSPORT LICENSES EMERGENCY REGULATIONS
1942, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 3rd day
of November, 1943

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Transport Licenses Emergency Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport Licenses Emergency Regulations 1942* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by adding the following regulation :—

“ 9. In considering any application for a passenger-service license or a goods-service license, or for the renewal, transfer, or amendment of a passenger-service license or a goods-service license, or for consent to the abandonment or curtailment of a passenger-service or a goods-service, the proper Licensing Authority shall, in addition to all other relevant considerations, take into account :—

“ (a) The desirability in the public interest of re-establishing in civil life discharged servicemen within the meaning of Part I of the Rehabilitation Act, 1941 :

“ (b) The undesirability in the public interest of granting any transfer of a license, or any new license in place of an existing license or a former license, where the Licensing Authority is of the opinion that on account of the surrender of the license the transferor or former licensee, as the case may be, is receiving valuable consideration which represents value attached to the license by reason of the licensing control exercised under the Transport Licensing Act, 1931, and which is excessive, whether by reason of the war or otherwise.”
