**THE TEACHERS' LEAVE OF ABSENCE REGULATIONS 1924,  
AMENDMENT NO. 6.**

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 30th day of  
November, 1938.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Education Act, 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Teachers' Leave of Absence Regulations 1924, Amendment No. 6.
2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made by Order in Council dated the 12th day of December, 1924\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.
4. The word "teacher," wherever it occurs in the principal regulations, shall be regarded also as a reference to a member of the staff of a teachers' training college.
