Pursuant to the Education Act, 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Teachers' Leave of Absence Regulations 1924, Amendment No. 6.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made by Order in Council dated the 12th day of December, 1924* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.
- **4.** The word "teacher," wherever it occurs in the principal regulations, shall be regarded also as a reference to a member of the staff of a teachers' training college.
