PURSUANT to the Transport Licensing Act, 1931, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Transport Licensing Passenger Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 2.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Transport Licensing Passenger Regulations 1936* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. Regulation 19 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the figures and words "£600 (six hundred pounds)" where used in clause (1) thereof, and substituting the figures and words "£650 (six hundred and fifty pounds)."
