PURSUANT to the Transport Licensing Act, 1931, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS.**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Transport Licensing Passenger Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 2.
2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Transport Licensing Passenger Regulations 1936\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
3. Regulation 19 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the figures and words “£600 (six hundred pounds)” where used in clause (1) thereof, and substituting the figures and words “£650 (six hundred and fifty pounds).”
