

THE TRANSPORT LICENSING PASSENGER REGULATIONS 1936, AMENDMENT NO. 5

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Transport Licensing Act, 1931, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Transport Licensing Passenger Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 5.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Transport Licensing Passenger Regulations 1936* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- **3.** These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.
- 4. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is amended by adding thereto the following clause:—
- "(3) It shall be a condition of every license (whether inserted therein or not) that the following provisions shall apply in respect of fares for children:—
 - "(a) For a child under the age of four years in care of a person of the age of fifteen years or over, no fare shall be payable:
 - "(b) For a child under the age of fifteen years (and not coming within the description in the last preceding paragraph) half adult fare shall be payable, except that in the case of any license which now makes provision for a reduced fare for children amounting to less than half adult fare (whether or not the upper age-limit for children as defined in such license is fifteen years), then a fare equal to such reduced fare shall be payable."
