**TRANSPORT LICENSING PASSENGER REGULATIONS 1936,  
AMENDMENT NO. 8**

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Licensing Act, 1931, His Excellency the Governor-General doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Transport Licensing Passenger Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 8.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport Licensing Passenger Regulations 1936\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the day next following the notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.

4. (1) Regulation 19 of the principal regulations, as amended by Regulation 4 of the Transport Licensing Passenger Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 4, is hereby further amended by revoking paragraph (i) of clause (2) thereof, and substituting the following paragraph :—

“(i) In addition to the payments authorized by clause (1) of this regulation there shall be paid to each member of a Licensing Authority for every day or part of a day on which he is occupied or engaged on the business of the

Authority, and while so occupied or engaged is absent from his usual place of residence, a further allowance by way of board and lodging expenses at the rate of £1 7s. 6d. for every such day or part of a day.”

(2) Regulation 4 of the Transport Licensing Passenger Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 4, is hereby revoked.
