## THE TRANSPORT LICENSING (GOODS-SERVICE) **REGULATIONS 1936, AMENDMENT NO. 2.**

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 14th day of February, 1940.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Transport Licensing Act, 1931, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Transport Licensing (Goods-service) Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 2.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Transport Licensing (Goods-service) Regulations 1936\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.<sup>+</sup>

4. The principal regulations are amended by inserting in Regulation 4 thereof the following additional clause :-

"(10) It shall be a condition of every license (whether inserted therein or not), unless otherwise provided by the express terms of the license or unless the license is issued in respect of a service carried on by a Government Department, or unless the service is required to be licensed solely by reason of the provisions of section 17 of the Transport Law Amendment Act, 1939, and is not carried on for hire or reward, that the licensee, if he is not already a member of some such organization as is hereinafter described, will, not later than the 29th day of February, 1940, or not later than the fourteenth day after the issue of the license, whichever date is the later, seek and obtain

membership in some organization if any exists which is incorporated under the Incorporated Societies Act, 1908, and membership of which is by its rules confined to licensees under the Transport Licensing Act, 1931, and membership of which entails no unreasonable burden or obligations upon members, and that in either case the licensee during the continuance of the license, and so long as membership entails no unreasonable burden or obligations upon members, shall pay all fees and do all things necessary to retain membership in some such organization as aforesaid."
