**THE TRANSPORT LICENSING REGULATIONS 1960,
AMENDMENT NO. 3**

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Transport Licensing Regulations 1960, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport Licensing Regulations 1960* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 7 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Transport Licensing Regulations 1960, Amendment No. 2) is hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph:

“(h) Every goods service carried on by a farmer for the carriage of his own fat lambs to freezing works or an abattoir.”

3. Regulation 29 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Transport Licensing Regulations 1960, Amendment No. 2) is hereby amended by adding to subclause (5) the following paragraph:

“(f) To the carriage of fat lambs to freezing works or an abattoir.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations exempt the carriage of fat lambs to freezing works or an abattoir by farmers and carriers from the 50-mile railway restriction.
