PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Transport Licensing Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 13, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport Licensing Regulations 1963\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1971.

**2. Offences and penalties**—Regulation 72 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (2), and substituting the following subclause:

“(2) Every person who commits an offence against these regulations, shall, without prejudice to his liability to any other penalty to which he may be liable, whether upon summary conviction or otherwise, and without prejudice to any other consequence arising from the breach, be liable to the penalties specified in subsection (4) of section 30 of the Transport Act 1962.”
