



**THE TRANSPORT LICENSING REGULATIONS 1963,
AMENDMENT NO. 17**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 26th day of June 1972

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Transport Licensing Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 17, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport Licensing Regulations 1963* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Annual returns—The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking Part B, and substituting the following part:

“PART B

ANNUAL FINANCIAL AND STATISTICAL RETURN

CONFIDENTIAL

ANNUAL RETURN BY PASSENGER, GOODS, TAXI, AND RENTAL OPERATORS
Year ended 31 March 19.....

(This information is required in accordance with the provisions of the Transport Act 1962 and regulations issued under that Act and its amendments.)

1. Main type of business operated (i.e., goods, passenger, rental, or taxi service)
2. If more than one type of licence is held, state nature and number of each type

 - Rental vehicles [*e.g., ten cars, one station wagon, four light trucks*]
 - Taxi cabs or private hire cars [*e.g., one 5-seater cab*]
4. (a) Total mileage for year
- (b) Less mileage run on other work or for private purposes
- (c) Total mileage run on licensed transport work
5. (a) Total gross revenue received for year
- (b) Less gross revenue from sale of goods or from other work
- (c) Total gross from transport work
6. (a) Total expenses for year
- (b) Less expenses from other work or goods purchased
- (c) Total expenses for transport work (to agree with 7)
7. Analysis of expenses for transport work:
 - Running costs—fuel
 - mileage tax
 - tyres
 - oil
 - repairs and maintenance
 - Wages and salaries (excluding drawings of working proprietors)
 - Fixed charges (licence fees, insurance, etc.)
 - Vehicle depreciation
 - Overhead and other expenses
 - Total transport expenses (to agree with 6 (c))
8. Number of employees:
 - (a) Drivers
 - (b) Mechanics
 - (c) Office staff and others
9. Owners engaged in business:
 - (a) Number
 - (b) Average weekly hours of work per person
10. Book value of assets in transport business:
 - (a) Vehicles
 - (b) Other assets (not to include goodwill)
 - (c) Total
11. Total liabilities in transport business (excluding shareholders' or owners' funds)
12. Total number of passengers carried during year (applies to passenger service (other than taxicab) operators only)

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations prescribe a new form of annual financial and statistical return to be furnished by licensees of goods services.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette*: 29 June 1972.

These regulations are administered in the Ministry of Transport.
