ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 13th day of April 1981

Pursuant to section 199 of the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Transport Licensing Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 26, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport Licensing Regulations 1963* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
 - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of May 1981.
- 2. Fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Sixth Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Transport Licensing Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 25), and substituting the Sixth Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- 3. Saving—Notwithstanding regulation 2 of these regulations, the annual fee payable in respect of a licence, vehicle authority, or vehicle for the whole or any part of the licensing year in which these regulations come into force shall be the fee prescribed by the principal regulations immediately before the commencement of these regulations or the

appropriate proportion of that fee, and any refund of such a fee shall be the refund that would have been made if these regulations had not been made.

4. Revocation—The Transport Licensing Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 25 are hereby revoked.
