

# THE TRANSPORT LICENSING REGULATIONS 1963, AMENDMENT NO. 28

## DAVID BEATTIE, Governor-General

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 19th day of April 1982

#### Present:

The Right Hon. D. S. Thomson presiding in Council Pursuant to section 199 of the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Transport Licensing Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 28, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport Licensing Regulations 1963\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
  - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of May 1982.
- **2. Fees for certain motor vehicles**—(1) Regulation 71 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (4) (as substituted by regulation 3 (1) of the Transport Licensing Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 23), and substituting the following subclause:

- "(4) The owner of a motor vehicle to which any of paragraphs (d), (g), and (h) of regulation 8 of the Motor Vehicles Registration and Licensing Regulations 1965\* applies shall, on making application for a licence for that vehicle under Part II of the Act, pay to the Deputy Registrar of Motor Vehicles the appropriate fees prescribed in clause 5 or clause 7 and clause 11 of the Sixth Schedule to these regulations, and no such licence shall be issued until those fees are paid."
- (2) Regulation 3 of the Transport Licensing Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 23 is hereby consequentially revoked.
- 3. Fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Sixth Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Transport Licensing Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 26), and substituting the Sixth Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- 4. Saving—Notwithstanding regulation 3 of these regulations, the annual fee payable in respect of a licence (other than a passenger service licence), vehicle authority, or vehicle (other than a passenger service vehicle that is not a taxi cab) for the whole or any part of the licensing year in which these regulations come into force shall be the fee prescribed by the principal regulations immediately before the commencement of these regulations or the appropriate proportion of that fee, and any refund of such a fee shall be the refund that would have been made if these regulations had not been made.
- **5. Revocation**—The Transport Licensing Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 26 are hereby revoked.
