ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 27th day of June 1983

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL
PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Administrator of
the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive
Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as
the Transport Licensing Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 31, and shall
be read together with and deemed part of the Transport Licensing
Regulations 1963* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date
of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Railway restriction—Regulation 24 (3) of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Transport Licensing Regulations 1962, Amendment No. 29 and other regulations) is hereby amended by adding the following subclause:

“(o) To the carriage of rubber tyres, rubber tyre flaps, rubber tiring, and rubber tyre tubes.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations extend the exemption from the rail restriction which applies to the carriage of goods by road where there is an available route including at least 150 km of Government railway.

The carriage of rubber tyres, rubber tyre flaps, rubber tiring, and rubber tyre tubes is now exempted from the restriction.
