



**THE TREES (ELECTRIC LINES) REGULATIONS 1986,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Electricity Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Trees (Electric Lines) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Trees (Electric Lines) Regulations 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Maintenance of lines—Regulation 15 (3) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “service of the notice”, and

substituting the words “expiry of the time stipulated in the notice for the tree cutting or trimming work to be carried out”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Trees (Electric Lines) Regulations 1986 to provide that the power given to electrical supply authorities to cut or trim trees after the service of a notice applies 10 days after the expiry of the time stipulated in the notice, and not 10 days after the service of the notice.
