PURSUANT to section 48 of the Transport (Vehicle and Driver Registration and Licensing) Act 1986, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Transport (Drivers Licensing) Regulations 1987, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport (Drivers Licensing) Regulations 1987* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
