PURSUANT to sections 48 and 48A of the Transport (Vehicle and Driver Registration and Licensing) Act 1986, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Transport (Drivers Licensing) Regulations 1987, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport (Drivers Licensing) Regulations 1987* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
 - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1992.

Penalties for breaches of conditions—Regulation 34 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "Chief Traffic Officer who is an officer of the Ministry of Transport", and substituting the words "commissioned officer of Police".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 1992, effect an amendment to the Transport (Drivers Licensing) Regulations 1987 that is consequential upon the transfer of Ministry of Transport traffic officers to the Police.
