**THE TRADE MARKS REGULATIONS 1954, AMENDMENT

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 6th day of December 1966

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Trade Marks Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trade Marks Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Trade Marks Regulations 1954* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking items 7 and 8, and substituting the following items:
