**THE TIMARU MILK TREATMENT CORPORATION  
REGULATIONS 1946, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington, this 29th day of July 1953

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Marketing Act 1936 and the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Timaru Milk Treatment Corporation Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Timaru Milk Treatment Corporation Regulations 1946\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (2), and substituting the following subclause:

“(2) Subject to the provisions of these regulations, the Corporation shall consist of five directors to be appointed from time to time by the Governor-General on the recommendation of the Minister either by name or as the holder or as the respective holders for the time being of any office or offices, of whom—

“(a) One shall be appointed as representative of the Government:

“(b) Two shall be appointed as representatives of the consumers on the nomination of the Timaru City Council:

“(c) Two shall be appointed as representatives of the producers on the nomination of the South Canterbury Co-operative Milk Supply Company, Limited.”

3. (1) The first directors of the Corporation as reconstituted by these regulations shall be appointed as soon as may be practicable after the commencement of these regulations. The directors holding office at the commencement of these regulations shall continue to hold office until the first directors appointed under this subclause come into office.

(2) Notwithstanding anything in the principal regulations, the term of office of the two directors first appointed as representatives of the consumers under subclause (1) of this regulation shall expire on the 1st day of April 1954.

4. Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (4) the word "four", and substituting the word "three".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*]

These regulations alter the constitution of the Timaru Milk Treatment Corporation by reducing the number of directors from seven to five, the number of consumers' and producers' representatives being reduced from three to two in each case. The quorum for meetings is consequentially reduced from four to three.
