PURSUANT to section 2A of the Telecommunications Act 1987, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Communications, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Telecommunications Network Operator (BellSouth New Zealand Limited) Order 1991.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1991.

2. BellSouth New Zealand Limited to be network operator—It is hereby declared that BellSouth New Zealand Limited is a network operator for the purposes of the Telecommunications Act 1987.
