ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 8th day of October 1990

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 2A of the Telecommunications Act 1987, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Communications, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Telecommunications Network Operators Order 1990.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day of November 1990.

2. The Alternate Telecommunications Company Limited to be network operator—It is hereby declared that The Alternate Telecommunications Company Limited is a network operator for the purposes of the Telecommunications Act 1987.

3. Broadcast Communications Limited to be network operator—It is hereby declared that Broadcast Communications Limited is a network operator for the purposes of the Telecommunications Act 1987.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 14 November 1990, declares that The Alternate Telecommunications Company Limited and Broadcast Communications Limited are network operators for the purposes of the Telecommunications Act 1987.
