PURSUANT to section 2A of the Telecommunications Act 1987, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Communications, makes the following order.



ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Telecommunications Network Operators Order 1997.

(2) This order comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Globalstar New Zealand Limited to be network operator—Globalstar New Zealand Limited is a network operator for the purposes of the Telecommunications Act 1987.

3. Mainland Television Limited to be network operator—
Mainland Television Limited is a network operator for the purposes of the Telecommunications Act 1987.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*, declares that Globalstar New Zealand Limited and Mainland Television Limited are network operators for the purposes of the Telecommunications Act 1987.
