## ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 2A of the Telecommunications Act 1987, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Communications, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Telecommunications Network Operators Order (No. 3) 1996.
  - (2) This order shall come into force on the 8th day of November 1996.
- **2. Franklin Cablevision Limited to be network operator**—It is hereby declared that Franklin Cablevision Limited is a network operator for the purposes of the Telecommunications Act 1987.

**3. Taupo Cablevision Inc Limited to be network operator**—It is hereby declared that Taupo Cablevision Inc Limited is a network operator for the purposes of the Telecommunications Act 1987.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on the 8th day of November 1996, declares that Franklin Cablevision Limited and Taupo Cablevision Inc Limited are network operators for the purposes of the Telecommunications Act 1987.
