PURSUANT to section 2A of the Telecommunications Act 1987, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Communications, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Telecommunications Network Operator (Integrity Television Limited) Order 1996.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1996.

**2. Integrity Television Limited to be network operator**—It is hereby declared that Integrity Television Limited is a network operator for the purposes of the Telecommunications Act 1987.
