PURSUANT to section 2A of the Telecommunications Act 1987, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Communications, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Telecommunications Network Operator (New Zealand Post Limited) Order 1993.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 20th day of May 1993.

2. New Zealand Post Limited to be network operator—It is hereby declared that New Zealand Post Limited is a network operator for the purposes of the Telecommunications Act 1987.
