THE TRAFFIC (PALMERSTON NORTH) REGULATIONS 1957

COBHAM, Governor-General ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 9th day of October 1957

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Palmerston North) Regulations 1957.

2. In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires,—

"Through street" means any street or portion of a street declared to be a through street under regulation 4 of these regulations: Expressions defined in the Traffic Regulations 1956* have the meanings so defined.

3. The Palmerston North City Council may from time to time, by resolution, declare any specified street or portion of a street in the city of Palmerston North to be a through street for the purposes of these regulations.

4. (1) Notwithstanding anything in regulation 11 of the Traffic Regulations 1956^* (which relates to the right hand rule at intersections) at any intersection of any street with a through street where the sign prescribed by regulation 5 of these regulations is erected as provided in that regulation the driver of any vehicle entering or crossing the through street shall yield the right of way to any other vehicle which is in the through street and is approaching or crossing the intersection, unless that other vehicle is controlled by signals in the form of lights or by a Traffic Officer or police officer.

(2) A driver shall not increase the speed of his vehicle when approaching or crossing any intersection at which any other vehicle has the right of way under this regulation.

5. At every intersection of a through street with any other street that is not itself a through street (not being an intersection controlled by signals in the form of lights), the Palmerston North City Council shall erect in that other street a sign in the form and of the colours described in the Schedule hereto located in accordance with the provisions of regulation 128 of the Traffic Regulations 1956.*

6. Every person who does any act in contravention of or fails to comply with the provisions of regulation 4 of these regulations is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding $\pounds 50$.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide for certain experimental through streets in Palmerston North in which vehicle traffic will have right of way over that emerging from side streets in which "Give Way" signs are erected.
