THE TRANSPORT (GOODS) ORDER, 1936, AMENDMENT NO. 1.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council. Act pursuant to which the regulations were made: Section 59 of the Transport Licensing Act, 1931.

Date on which the regulations were made: 16th day of September, 1936.

Date of notification in Gazette: 17th day of September, 1936.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Transport (Goods) Order, 1936, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.

3. Subparagraph (c) of paragraph (4) of the Transport (Goods) Order, 1936,* is amended by revoking all the words thereof down to the words "exempted areas, namely," and substituting the following words :---

"A goods-service in which the goods are carried or hauled solely from a place within any one of the urban areas or exempted areas hereinafter described to another place within the same urban area or exempted area respectively.

"(i) The urban areas hereinbefore referred to are the respective areas lying within a radius of six miles from the post-office, or chief post-office, or principal post-office, as the case may be, of each of the following cities and boroughs, namely :---

Whangarei.	Hastings.	Nelson.
Hamilton.	New Plymouth.	Greymouth.
Rotorua.	Wanganui.	Timaru.
Gisborne.	Palmerston North.	Oamaru.
Napier.	Masterton.	Invercargill.

" (ii) The exempted areas hereinbefore referred to are the following, namely :---"
