THE TRANSPORT (PASSENGER) ORDER 1936, AMENDMENT NO. 1, AND THE TRANSPORT LICENSING PASSENGER REGULATIONS 1936, AMENDMENT NO. 3.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 14th day of February, 1940.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Transport Licensing Act, 1931, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth hereby order as follows:—

PART I.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Transport (Passenger) Order 1936, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. Subject to the next succeeding clause hereof, this Order shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.*
- 3. Clause 4 of this Order shall come into force on the 15th day of February, 1940.
- 4. The First Part of the Second Schedule to the Transport (Passenger) Order 1936† is amended by revoking the descriptions of Number One Transport District and of Number Two Transport District, and substituting therefor the following:—

"Number One Transport District.

"All that area of the North Island bounded to the east, north, and west by the sea, and to the south by a line following the southern boundary of the Waitomo County from the sea to the western boundary of the Taupo County; thence by the western and southern boundary of the Taupo County to the south-western boundary of the Wairoa County; and thence by the western and north-western boundary of the Waikohu County; thence by the south-western boundary of the Waikohu County to the south-eastern boundary of the Opotiki County; and thence by the south-eastern and eastern boundary of the Opotiki County to the sea, including all the area of Great Barrier County and of Waiheke Island, but excluding all that area within the Auckland Transport District.

"Number Two Transport District.

"All that area of the North Island bounded to the east, south, and west by the sea, and to the north by the southern boundary of the Number One Transport District hereinbefore defined, but excluding all that area within the Wellington Transport District."

PART II.

- 5. Part II of this Order (comprising clauses 5 and 6 hereof) may be cited as the Transport Licensing Passenger Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 3.
- 6. The Transport Licensing Passenger Regulations 1936,* as set out in the Third Schedule to the Transport (Passenger) Order 1936, are amended by inserting, next after Regulation 5 thereof, the following additional regulation:—
 - "REGULATION 5A.—COMPULSORY MEMBERSHIP OF TRANSPORT ORGANIZATION.
- "It shall be a condition of every license (whether inserted therein or not), unless otherwise provided by the express terms of the license or unless the license is issued in respect of a service carried on by a Government Department, that the licensee, if he is not already a member of some such organization as is hereinafter described, will, not later than the 29th day of February, 1940, or not later than the fourteenth day after the issue of the license, seek and obtain membership in some organization if any exists which is incorporated under the Incorporated Societies Act, 1908, and membership of which is by its rules confined to licensees under the Transport Licensing Act, 1931, and membership of which entails no unreasonable burden or obligations upon members, and that in either case the licensee during the continuance of the license, and so long as membership entails no unreasonable burden or obligations upon members, shall pay all fees and do all things necessary to retain membership in some such organization as aforesaid."
