



**TRANSPORT (MEASUREMENT OF WEIGHT) AMENDMENT  
NOTICE 1999**

PURSUANT to sections 2 and 218 of the Land Transport Act 1998, the Minister of Police gives the following notice.

NOTICE

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Transport (Measurement of Weight) Amendment Notice 1999, and is part of the Transport (Measurement of Weight) Notice 1997\* (“the principal notice”).

(2) This notice comes into force on 1 March 1999.

**2. Interpretation**—Clause 2 of the principal notice is amended by revoking the definition of the term “testing authority”, and substituting the following definition:

“‘Testing authority’ means any person referred to in section 147 (2) (a) of the Land Transport Act 1998.”

**3. Approved weighing devices**—Clause 3 of the principal notice is amended by revoking subclause (1), and substituting the following subclause:

“(1) The weighing devices described in subclause (2) are approved for the purposes of recording or displaying the weight of a wheel, an axle, a group of axles, or a vehicle as required by the definition of the term ‘weight’ in section 2 (1) of the Land Transport Act 1998.”
