**THE TRANSPORT (MEASUREMENT OF WEIGHT)  
NOTICE 1969, AMENDMENT NO. 2**

PURSUANT to section 2 (1) of the Transport Act 1962 (as amended by section 5 (2) of the Transport Amendment Act 1968), the Minister of Transport hereby gives the following notice.

**NOTICE**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Transport (Measurement of Weight) Notice 1969, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport (Measurement of Weight) Notice 1969\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Approved weighing devices**—The principal notice is hereby amended by repealing the First Schedule, and substituting the following Schedule:

**“FIRST SCHEDULE**

**“APPROVED WEIGHING DEVICES**

“1. Any weighbridge or portable wheel-weigher which has been tested (whether before or after the commencement of this Schedule) by an Inspector of Weights and Measures and found accurate.

“2. Any weighbridge or portable wheel-weigher having stamped thereon (whether before or after the commencement of this Schedule) a mark of verification under the Weights and Measures Act 1925.”

This notice approves the use of weighing devices which although tested by an Inspector of Weights and Measures have not been stamped by him with a mark of verification under the Weights and Measures Act 1925.
