THE TIMBER PRODUCTION ADVISORY COMMITTEE REGULATIONS 1949, AMENDMENT NO. 1

THE HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Forests Act, 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Timber Production Advisory Committee Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed part of the Timber Production Advisory Committee Regulations 1949* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following the notification in the Gazette of the making thereof.
- 4. Regulation 13 of the principal regulations is hereby revoked, and the following regulation substituted therefor:—

$\hbox{``Iravelling-allowances}$

- "13. (1) The Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949† shall apply to and shall be deemed to be incorporated in these regulations so as to relate to the Committee and the members thereof.
- "(2) The subsistence allowance referred to in Regulation 5 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949 shall be at the rate of £1 15s. a day:
- "Provided that where a member is entitled to a subsistence allowance and occupies a hotel room for one night only, an additional amount of 2s. may be paid to that member.

"(3) The mileage allowance referred to in Regulation 13 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949 shall be calculated in accordance with the following table:—

Horse-power of Car.	Mileage Allowance.
Not exceeding $9\frac{1}{2}$ Exceeding $9\frac{1}{2}$ but not exceeding $14\frac{1}{2}$ Over $14\frac{1}{2}$	 $5\frac{1}{2}$ d. a mile. $6\frac{1}{4}$ d. a mile. 7d. a mile.

"(4) Garage expenses payable to a member pursuant to this regulation shall not exceed 2s. 6d. for every night on which any such expenses are incurred."
