**THE TIMBER PRODUCTION ADVISORY COMMITTEE  
REGULATIONS 1949, AMENDMENT NO. 2**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 7th day of

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Forests Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Timber Production Advisory Committee Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Timber Production Advisory Committee Regulations 1949\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding to subclause (1) the following paragraphs :—

“ (h) One person to be appointed by the Minister to represent the Dominion Forest Owners’ Federation (Incorporated) :

“ (i) One person to be appointed by the Minister to represent Maori forest owners.”

3. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by omitting from paragraph (d) of subclause (1) the words “ Dominion Federated Sawmillers’ Association (Incorporated)”, and substituting the words “ Dominion Sawmillers’ Federation (Incorporated) ”.

4. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (2) the words “ and (g)”, and substituting the words “ (g), and (h) ”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*]

These regulations increase the membership of the Timber Production Advisory Committee by adding one member to represent the Dominion Forest Owners' Federation (Incorporated) and one member to represent Maori forest owners. Clause 3 recognizes the change of name of one of the bodies represented on the committee.
