ORDER IN COUNCIL

Present:

The Right Hon. R. D. Muldoon presiding in Council Pursuant to the Forests Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Timber Preservation Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Timber Preservation Regulations 1955* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Membership of Timber Preservation Authority—(1) Regulation 3 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraphs (a) and (e).

(2) Regulation 3 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by adding, after paragraph (1), the following paragraph:

"(m) One member who shall be appointed on the nomination of the Federated Farmers of New Zealand Incorporated.".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations alter the membership of the Timber Preservation Authority by omitting the representatives of the Department of Trade and Industry and the Department of Scientific and Industrial Research and adding a representative of the Federated Farmers of New Zealand Incorporated.
