THE TROUT-FISHING (TARANAKI) REGULATIONS, 1936.

Enacting authority : His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.
Act pursuant to which the regulations were made : The Fisheries Act, 1908.

Date on which the regulations were made : 28th day of October, 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette* : 5th day of November, 1936.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Taranaki) Regulations, 1936.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations for the Taranaki Acclimatization District and the waters thereof made on the 8th day of December, 1924* (hereinafter called "the principal regulations").

3. The Trout-fishing (Taranaki) Regulations, 1936 (Serial Number 39/1936), made on the 30th day of September, 1936, are revoked.

4. (a) No person shall fish for trout or perch with more than one rod and line : Provided that a landing-net or gaff may be used to secure any trout or perch caught with such rod and line.

(b) No person shall, in fishing for trout or perch, use any bait or lure other than the natural fly, artificial fly, natural minnow, artificial minnow, or any small indigenous fish or insect.

(c) No person shall use any of the baits mentioned in the clause immediately preceding except upon a running line attached to a rod and reel.

(d) No person shall, in fishing for trout or perch, use any set rod or set line.

(e) No person shall, in fishing for trout or perch, use any houhou-grub or worms.

(f) On and after the first day of October, 1936, no person shall take trout or perch by any means whatsoever in the Makatawa River, from the main road to the source of the river.
