**THE TROUT-FISHING (WELLINGTON) REGULATIONS 1936,
AMENDMENT NO. 1.**

Enacting authority : His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.
Act pursuant to which the regulations were made : The Fisheries Act, 1908.

Date on which the regulations were made : 8th day of September, 1937.

Date of notification in *Gazette* : 16th day of September, 1937.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Wellington) Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Wellington) Regulations 1936* (hereinafter referred to as the "principal regulations").

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1937.

4. The regulations for trout-fishing in the Feilding and District Acclimatization District set out in the Schedule hereto are revoked.

5. The principal regulations as hereby amended shall henceforward apply to the area comprised in the Wellington Acclimatization District as constituted by Warrant of the Governor-General bearing date the 10th day of August, 1937.

6. Clause (b) of Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking item (7) thereof, and substituting the following :—

“(7) The Oroua River except the stretch of water between the Menzies Ford Bridge and the Aorangi Bridge.”

7. Clause (b) of Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is further amended by adding thereto the following additional item :—

“(22) The Pohangina River.”
