PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Traffic Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 14, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Traffic Regulations 1936* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. (1) Regulation 11 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 7 of the Traffic Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 1, and amended by regulation 3 of the Traffic Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 10) is hereby further amended by omitting from subclause (2) the words "fee of 3s. 6d.", and substituting the words "fee of 3s. 6d., in the case of a warrant issued in respect of a motor cycle or a trailer, and a fee of 5s. in the case of a warrant issued in respect of any other kind of motor vehicle".

(2) Regulation 3 of the Traffic Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 10, is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations increase from 3s. 6d. to 5s. the fee payable for warrants of fitness in the case of warrants for motor vehicles, other than motor cycles or trailers, that are issued by city authorities. The fee for warrants issued for motor cycles and trailers is to remain unchanged at 3s. 6d.
