THE TROUT-FISHING (WHANGAREI) REGULATIONS 1937, AMENDMENT NO. 1.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 21st day of September, 1938.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Whangarei) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Whangarei) Regulations 1937* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1938.
- 4. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following regulation substituted—
- "4. Whole-season licenses to fish for trout and other acclimatized fish issued by the Whangarei Acclimatization Society, or any other acclimatization society, under the general regulations shall entitle the holder to fish for trout and other acclimatized fish in the Whangarei Acclimatization District (hereinafter called "the said district") during any time between the 1st day of October in any one year and the 30th day of April in the year next following (both days inclusive)."
