**THE TROUT-FISHING (WAIMATE) REGULATIONS 1937,
AMENDMENT NO. 1.**

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 23rd day of August, 1939.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Waimate) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Waimate) Regulations 1937* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 15th day of October, 1939.

4. Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following regulation substituted :—

“ 9. (a) The period within which holders of licenses issued in manner prescribed by Regulation 5 hereof may fish in the rivers and waters mentioned in clause (b) hereof shall be from the 15th day of October in any year until the 30th day of April following.

“ (b) The rivers and waters within the district referred to in the preceding clause hereof are the following, namely :—

- “ (i) The Waitaki River.
- “ (ii) The tributaries of the Waitaki River.
- “ (iii) The Ahuriri River.
- “ (iv) The tributaries of the Ahuriri River.
- “ (v) The Ohau River.
- “ (vi) The tributaries of the Ohau River.
- “ (vii) Lake Ohau.
- “ (viii) The tributaries of Lake Ohau.
- “ (ix) Lake Middleton.
- “ (x) The tributaries of Lake Middleton.
- “ (xi) Lake Waitaki.”
