## THE TROUT-FISHING (WAIMARINO) REGULATIONS 1937, AMENDMENT NO. 1.

# GALWAY, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 27th day of September, 1939.

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Waimarino) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Waimarino) Regulations 1937\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1939.
- 4. Clause (a) of Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following clause substituted:—
  - "(a) If taken in or from—
    - "(1) The Mangawhero Stream;
    - "(2) The Whakapapa-nui River;
    - "(3) The tributaries of the Whakapapa-nui River;
    - "(4) The Whakapapa-iti River;
    - "(5) The tributaries of the Whakapapa-iti River;
    - "(6) The Wanganui River,—

is less than 12 in. in length from tip of nose to tip of tail."
