**THE TROUT-FISHING (WAIMARINO) REGULATIONS 1937,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1.**

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 27th day of  
September, 1939.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Waimarino) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Waimarino) Regulations 1937\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1939.

4. Clause (a) of Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following clause substituted :—

“(a) If taken in or from—

“(1) The Mangawhero Stream ;

“(2) The Whakapapa-nui River ;

“(3) The tributaries of the Whakapapa-nui River ;

“(4) The Whakapapa-iti River ;

“(5) The tributaries of the Whakapapa-iti River ;

“(6) The Wanganui River,—

is less than 12 in. in length from tip of nose to tip of tail.”
