Pursuant to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Waitaki) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 2.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Waitaki) Regulations 1937* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1939.
- 4. Regulation 12 of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following regulation substituted:—
- "12. No person shall troll for fish from any motor or other mechanically-propelled launch or boat in any part of Lake Ohau or Lake Middleton."
