**THE TROUT-FISHING (WAITAKI) REGULATIONS 1937,
AMENDMENT NO. 2.**

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 9th day of June, 1939.

Present :

THE RIGHT HON. M. J. SAVAGE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Waitaki) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 2.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Waitaki) Regulations 1937* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1939.

4. Regulation 12 of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following regulation substituted:—

“ 12. No person shall troll for fish from any motor or other mechanically-propelled launch or boat in any part of Lake Ohau or Lake Middleton.”
