**THE TROUT-FISHING (WAIMATE) REGULATIONS 1937,  
AMENDMENT NO. 2.**

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Waimate) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 2.
2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Waimate) Regulations 1937 (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations) and the amendment thereof.\*
3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1940.
4. The principal regulations are amended by inserting, next following Regulation 10, the following additional regulation:—  
“ 10A. No person shall when fishing in the Hakataramea Stream use any worm, grub, or creeper.”
