**THE TROUT-FISHING (NELSON) REGULATIONS 1937,
AMENDMENT NO. 2.**

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 3rd day of July, 1940.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Nelson) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 2.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Nelson) Regulations 1937* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is amended by adding the following two items thereto:—

“ (4) The Motupiko River :

“ (5) The tributaries of the Motupiko River.”
