THE TROUT-FISHING (ASHBURTON) REGULATIONS 1937, AMENDMENT NO. 3.

GALWAY, Governor-General.
ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 4th day of September, 1940.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Ashburton) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 3.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Ashburton) Regulations 1937 (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations) and the amendments thereof.*
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1940.
- **4.** Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following regulation substituted:—
- "6. No person shall fish for trout or other acclimatized fish in the said district from the 1st day of May in any one year to the 30th day of September in the same year."
- 5. Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following regulation substituted:—
- "7. The period from the 1st day of October in any one year to the 30th day of April in the year next following (both days inclusive) is hereby prescribed a close season for the waters comprised in Lake Howard (generally known as Lake Camp) and Lake Emily."

6. The principal regulations are amended by inserting, next after Regulation 17 thereof, the following additional regulation:—

"17a. No person shall take, attempt to take, or kill any trout, or other acclimatized fish in Lake Tripp (generally known as Lake Clearwater) or Lake Emma by means of a bait-casting rod."

7. Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is revoked.
