



**THE TROUT-FISHING (NELSON) REGULATIONS 1937,

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Nelson) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 3.
2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Nelson) Regulations 1937\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1944.
4. Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the word "ten" wherever it appears therein, and substituting the word "five".
5. The Trout-fishing (Nelson) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 1, are revoked.
