REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Auckland) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 4.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Auckland) Regulations 1937 and the amendments thereof.*
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1940.
- **4.** Column 1 of the Schedule to the Trout-fishing (Auckland) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 2, is amended by inserting, after the word "Ngatuwera", the word "Matahura".
