PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Otago) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 5.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Otago) Regulations 1937* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1941.

4. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is amended—

(i) By revoking clause (c) hereof:

(ii) By revoking the words "clauses (b) and (c) hereof" contained in clause (a) of the said regulation, and substituting the following words : " clause (b) hereof ".
