THE TROUT-FISHING (WAITAKI) REGULATIONS 1937, AMENDMENT NO. 5

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Waitaki) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 5.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Waitaki) Regulations 1937* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1943.
- 4. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is amended by deleting the words "subject as hereinafter appears".
- 5. Paragraph (a) of Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the words "twelve inches", and substituting the words "fourteen inches".
- 6. Paragraph (b) of Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the words "twelve inches", and substituting the words "fourteen inches".
 - 7. Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is hereby revoked.
- 8. Regulation 11 of the principal regulations, as substituted by Regulation 4 of the Trout-fishing (Waitaki) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 3, is revoked.
- 9. The Trout-fishing (Waitaki) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 3, are consequentially revoked.

- 10. The principal regulations are amended by inserting therein, after Regulation 10 thereof and next after the heading "Local Restrictions", the following regulation:—
- "11. No person shall on any one day take or kill in that part of the Waitaki River within the said district more than fifteen trout or more than 20 lb. weight of trout, and no person shall continue to fish for trout on any day on which he has already taken or killed fifteen trout or more than 20 lb. weight of trout:
- "Provided, first, that the weight-limit of 20 lb. shall not apply until such person has taken or killed not less than six fish in any one day:
- day:
 "Provided, secondly, that the quantities hereby specified shall be exclusive of any fish taken and dealt with pursuant to Regulations 49 and 50 of the General Regulations:
- "Provided, thirdly, that this regulation shall not apply to the fishing for, taking, or killing of trout in the course of an angling competition duly authorized by an acclimatization society."
- 11. Regulations 12A, 12B, and 12c of the principal regulations, as inserted by Regulation 6 of the Trout-fishing (Waitaki) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 4, are revoked, and the following regulations substituted:—
- "12A. During the period from the 1st day of October, 1943, to the 30th day of April, 1944 (both days inclusive), no person shall fish for trout or other acclimatized fish in that portion of the Oamaru Creek from the bridge at Severn Street to the waterfall at Meeks Mill.
- "12B. No person other than the holder of a license issued to a woman or to a person under sixteen years of age shall fish for trout or other acclimatized fish in the Kakanui River with any steel trace.
- "12c. During the period from the 1st day of October to the 31st day of December in any year no person other than the holder of a license issued to a woman or to a person under sixteen years of age shall fish for trout or other acclimatized fish with worm bait in the Kakanui River."
- 12. The Trout-fishing (Waitaki) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 4, are revoked.
